2026 Show Series Information

- ❖ **The office fee is non-refundable, under any circumstances, after the closing date.**
- ❖ All entries received after noon on the Wednesday before the show will be charged a post entry fee of \$40/entry.
- ❖ We recommend entries be made electronically via email or www.horseshowing.com. Entries may be sent via USPS, but please allow extra time for delivery.
- ❖ **In order to accumulate NH Medal points and/or points for NHHJA year end awards, membership fee must be paid AND membership form must be completed prior to the conclusion of the show. Note: Juniors need parent signature.**
- ❖ Unjudged warm-ups are available as listed on the class schedule.
- ❖ Shows start promptly at **7:30 in Rings 1 & 2** and **8:00 in Ring 3**.
- ❖ All entries are required to pay \$2 NEHC fee.
- ❖ Returned checks will be charged a fee of \$100. Payment of return fee and initial amount shall be made within 2 weeks of notification.
- ❖ Classes with less than 3 entries will run, but prize money will not be awarded. Points will be awarded toward year end awards.
- ❖ All prize money will be applied to show bill. Excess winnings will be mailed within 30 days.
- ❖ NHHJA management reserves the right to limit entries or cancel any class, section or division; to change, add a dotted line, cancel or combine any unfilled classes; or to reschedule classes, change rings or change specifications in jumper classes due to time constraints.
- ❖ NHHJA horse shows abide by the rules and regulations of the New England Horsemen's Council and USEF.
- ❖ All entries for NEHC medal classes must have their membership number or a copy of their temporary membership card with them. Entries without membership numbers will not be accepted. If you know you are a member and cannot remember your number, you can fill out a Membership Affidavit. There is a \$25.00 fee which will be returned to you when your membership is validated. If you join NEHC at the horse show, please make sure you get your Temporary Membership from the show office.
- ❖ Helmets must meet or exceed ASTM/SEI safety standards and be must worn at all times when mounted. Chin straps must be securely fastened.
- ❖ Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- ❖ **Credit cards will be accepted Amex, Visa, Mastercard and Discover. There will be a 3% fee added to your total.**
- ❖ Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary

license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- ❖ ****NEW FOR 2026**Vaccine records and Coggins must be emailed to the show secretary prior to arriving on the show grounds. If you plan to enter the day of, please bring copies with you to leave with the show office.**

- ❖ Horse Health Requirements include negative coggins within 12 months; EIV (Equine Influenza) and EHV-1/EHV-4 (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccines within 6 months. In addition, horses must have shown no signs of infectious disease and may not had a fever above 102 degrees F within 72 hours of arrival.

2026 NHHJA HORSE SHOW CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Equitation Classes

\$30/Class

No rider may enter classes for more than one age group. The exhibitors' age for competition will follow NEHC rules, age as of December 1st. Points can be accumulated only in the age group indicated on the application for membership. Martingales are prohibited on the flat.

Lead Line – Open to riders 8 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk and trot. Not to show in any other class/division at the same show. Leader and side-walkers must be over the age of 14 and appropriately dressed. Riders may not have competed off the lead.

Hunt Seat Walk-Trot Equitation – Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Shall show at a walk and trot only. Reverse at walk. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope. Rider must not have EVER been judged in a class at a ANY show that required a canter on the show grounds or warm-up. No tests will be called. NEHC "A"

Hunt Seat Walk-Trot Equitation Championship – same specifications as Hunt Seat Walk-Trot Equitation class above. Must have entered, shown, and judged in the Hunt Seat Walk-Trot class in order to show in the Hunt Seat Walk-Trot Equitation Championship class. NEHC "A"

Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown higher than 18" at any recognized show. NEHC "A"

Short Stirrup Equitation Flat – to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at one time.

Short Stirrup Equitation O/F – to be shown over a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences, with fences not to exceed 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter.

Long Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 13 years of age and older. Riders cannot have shown higher than 2' at any recognized show.

Long Stirrup Equitation Flat – to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at one time.

Long Stirrup Equitation O/F – to be shown over a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences, with fences not to exceed 18' in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter.

Hunt Seat Equitation Under 12 – fence heights not to exceed 2'.

NEHC "A"

Hunt Seat Equitation 12-17 – fence heights not to exceed 3’.

NEHC "A"

Amateur Adult Equitation – fence heights not to exceed 2’9”.

NEHC "A"

Modified Children’s Equitation – fences not to exceed 2’3”. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2’6” at any recognized show.

Modified (Low) Amateur Adult Equitation – fences 2’3”-2’6”. Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven’t shown higher than 2’9” at a recognized show in the current show season. Riders in this division cannot show in any other classes at the same show where fences exceed 2’6”.

NEHC "A"

Children’s Equitation - fence heights not to exceed 2’6” for horses/large ponies, 2’ for small/medium ponies. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 3’ at any recognized show.

NEHC "A"

Pre Child/Adult Equitation - Open to junior or amateur adult riders who have not shown higher than 2’6” at a recognized show in the current show season. Fence heights not to exceed 2’.

Medal Classes

\$40/Class

NH Medal Notes: Riders must be NHHJA members to accumulate points for finals. Previous Medal Finals winners are still eligible to compete in qualifying classes, but must follow specifications below for NH Medal Finals eligibility.

NH Adult Medal – fences not to exceed 2’9”. Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-23. *NH Adult Medal and NH Junior Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

Note: When rider wins Adult medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals, but may return to compete in the class the following year.

NH Junior Medal – fences not to exceed 3’. Junior riders must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-23. *NH Junior Medal and NH Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

Note: When rider wins Junior medal class at year-end finals, the rider no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

NH Mini Medal - fence heights not to exceed 2’6” for large ponies/horses, 2’ for small/medium ponies. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 3’ at any recognized show. Children’s riders must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. *NH Mini Medal, NH Modified Children’s Medal and/or NH Adult Mini Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

Note: If a rider wins Mini medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals.

NH Modified Children’s Medal – fence heights not to exceed 2’3”. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2’6” at a recognized show. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. *NH Modified Children’s Medal, NH Adult Mini and/or NH Mini Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

Note: When rider wins Modified Children’s medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals.

NH Adult Mini Medal – fence 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'9" at a recognized show in the current show season. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. *NH Adult Mini Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Mini Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

Note: When rider wins Adult Mini medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals, but may return to compete in the class the following year.

NH Novice Medal – fence heights not to exceed 18". Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have never shown higher than 2' at a recognized show. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. Simple changes shall not be penalized. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge.

Note: When rider wins Novice medal class at year-end finals 2 years consecutively, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

***New* NH Pre Child/Adult Medal** - fence heights not to exceed 2'. Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have not shown higher than 2'3" at a recognized show in the current show season. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge.

Note: When rider wins Pre Child/Adult medal class at year-end finals 2 years consecutively, he/ she is no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

NEHC Adult Medal - Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a height from 2'9" to 3' with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-23). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. If there are not 3 riders of either or both the Junior or Adult Hunt Seat Medal qualifying class, they can be combined to meet the 3 rider minimum. Riders would show at their respective heights.

NEHC Junior Medal - Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set to a height from 3' to 3'3" with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-23). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. If there are not 3 riders of either or both the Junior or Adult Hunt Seat Medal qualifying class, they can be combined to meet the 3 rider minimum. Riders would show at their respective heights.

MHJ Short Stirrup Medal (class #54 qualifying class) – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. To perform over at least four fences not to exceed 18". Riders **may not** compete in any other equitation class other than Short Stirrup Equitation, at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18". Any Short Stirrup Equitation class(es) or Championship class may be used as the qualifying Class as long as the show program specifies. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

MHJ Long Stirrup Medal (class #52 qualifying class) – Open to junior and adult riders 13 years of age and older. To be shown over at least four fences not to exceed 18". Riders shall not have competed in a class jumping higher than 18" at the same show. Any Long Stirrup Equitation class may be used as the qualifying class as long as the show program specifies. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

MHJ Mini Medal – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year [exception Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year.] To perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6". At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class. Riders may cross-enter into the Children's equitation Medal but can only compete in either the Mini-Medal Children's Equitation Medal but not both at the finals.

MHJ Adult Mini Medal - Open to all Adult Amateur riders that have not shown over a course where the fences exceeded 3' in the current year. To perform over a course of at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count. Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal.

MHJ Adult Medal – Open to all Adult Amateur competitors to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least two changes of direction and a combination. At the finals, class will be divided 18-30 and 31 and over. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

MHJ Junior Medal – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 Points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

MHJ Children's Equitation Medal– Open to all horses and ponies. Open to riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Riders may not cross enter into junior equitation. Fences 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6' for large ponies/horses. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count.

Pleasure Classes

\$30/Pleasure and Walk Trot Championship

\$35/Championship

Walk-Trot Pleasure – Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To be shown at a walk, and trot ONLY. To be judged on manners, suitability or a horse/pony to rider and performance. Reverse at walk. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope at the current show. May not have cantered or loped in any class at a previous show. NEHC "AA"

Walk-Trot Pleasure Championship – same specifications as Walk-Trot Pleasure class above. Must have entered, shown, and judged in the Walk-Trot Pleasure class in order to show in the Walk-Trot Pleasure Championship class. NEHC "A'A"

Pony Hunter Pleasure – Open to all ponies of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. Adults are permitted to show ponies with suitability to count; light contact with the pony's mouth is required. To be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance and soundness. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. May be asked to hand gallop, halt and back. Open to ponies only.

Pony Hunter Pleasure Championship – Specifications to be the same as qualifying class. To be eligible, ponies must have been entered, shown and judged in Pony Hunter Pleasure (Class #121). Prize Money: \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Hunter Pleasure Horse – Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations to status of rider. Light contact with horse's mouth is required. To be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance and soundness. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. May be asked to hand gallop, halt and back. Open to horses only, ponies are not eligible. NEHC "AA"

Hunter Pleasure Horse Championship - Specifications to be the same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in the Hunter Pleasure (Class #123). Prize Money: \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5
NEHC "AA"

NEHC Open Pleasure Horse or Pony – Open to NEHC members and non-members. Open to all horses and ponies ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of rider or place of residence. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order. NEHC "C"

Jumper Divisions

\$40/Class

Prize Money in all jumper classes: \$50, \$25, \$15, \$10.

Tables as noted on class schedule.

Novice Jumper - Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Fences 2'

Puddle Jumper – Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Fences 2'6".

Schooling Jumper – Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Fences 3'.

Open Jumper – Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Fences 3"-3'3". NEHC "A"

Hunter Divisions

\$30/Class

\$40/Stake

- Prize money in stake classes is \$50, \$25, \$15, \$10. Other classes will be awarded trophy and 6 ribbons.
- Must have shown in all hunter over fences classes to be eligible to compete in division's stake class.
- At least two over fences classes and the under saddle class must be completed in order to award division championships. In addition, at least two horses must complete a division in order to award division championships.
- Fences must simulate obstacles found in the hunting field such as natural post and rail, brush, stone wall, white board fence or gate, chicken coop, aiken, hedge, etc... A ground line is recommended for all fences. The top element must be

securely placed so that slight rubs will not cause a knockdown. Open jumper fences such as striped rails and bull's eye panels are discouraged. An in-and-out must never be the first fence.

Hunter Prep – This class is designed as a warm up round and is open all horses and riders. To be open all day, or as specified, and run at current fence heights. Riders must specify that their round is a Prep round. Only one round is permitted per horse, unless time allows. Ribbons will not be awarded for Prep classes.

Short Stirrup Hunter Division – Open to riders 12 years of age and under. May not compete in any other hunter divisions in a jumping class where fences are higher than 18". May never have shown over fences higher than 18" at any recognized show. To be shown over 4 to 8 fences not to exceed 18". Simple changes of lead should not be penalized. No more than 8 to canter at one time in under saddle class. NEHC "AA"

Suitable Hunter Division – Horse **and/or** rider may never have competed in a class with fence heights greater than 2' at a recognized show. To be shown over 4 to 8 fences not to exceed 18" with no combinations. May trot or canter fences. Simple changes of lead should not be penalized. No more than 8 to canter at one time in under saddle class.

Pre Child/Adult Hunter Division – Open to junior or amateur adult exhibitors who have not previously shown over fences exceeding 2'6" in height at a recognized show. Open to horses and ponies to show over the same course. Fence heights not to exceed 2'.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter Division – Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Riders may not cross enter into any other class or section where fences exceed 2'9" at the same competition. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

NEHC "B"

Low Children's Hunter Division – Open to junior riders. Riders may not cross enter into any other class or section where fences exceed 2'9" at the same competition. Fences not to exceed 2'6". NEHC "B"

Modified Child/Adult Hunter Division – Open to junior riders who have not previously shown over fences exceeding 2'6" in height at a recognized show. Open to horses and ponies to show over the same course. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

Baby Green Hunter Division – Open to any horse or pony in their first two years of showing over fences. Horses and ponies qualify for the Baby Green division for a maximum of two years only. Horses and ponies may not cross enter in other divisions with jumps exceeding 2'6", and may not to have previously shown over fences exceeding 2'6" in height at any recognized show. Simple changes of lead should not be penalized. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

Open Special Hunter Division – Open to any horse or pony regardless of status. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

Children's Hunter Pony Division – Same judging specifications as Children's Hunter Horse division. Fence heights not to exceed 2' for small & medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies. Ponies may not cross enter into the regular pony hunter division. NEHC "B"

Adult Amateur Hunter Division – To be ridden by amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as juniors. Horse/rider combinations are not eligible for any other NEHC rated hunter classes. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other divisions or classes at the same show. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners and way of going, size of rider to mount and suitability as an amateur adult hunter. Horses may be jogged for soundness at the judge's discretion. Fence heights not to exceed 3'. Spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. May be split 18-35 years of age and 36 years of age & over if entries warrant.

NEHC "B"

Children's Hunter Horse Division – To be shown by junior exhibitors, age as of December 1st of the current show year. Junior exhibitors 15-17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate equitation O/F (have not won 12 blue ribbons) as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 3'0, spreads not to exceed fence height. If entries warrant, the division may be split at the discretion of the management. Same horse/rider combinations may not compete in any other NEHC rated division at the same show except equitation, jumpers, and pleasure. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division at the same show. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge. Shall be judged on performance and soundness.
