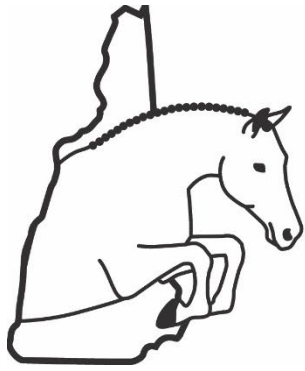

Directions to Fieldstone Show Park – 21 Plymouth St. Halifax, MA

From the North: Take I-93 S to Route 3 via Exit 7 toward Cape Code, Braintree. Keep LEFT to merge onto MA-3 S. Take MA-3 to route 3A via Exit 9 toward Kingston, N Plymouth. Turn right onto Main St. go .5 miles and turn left to stay on Main St. continue onto Wapping Rd. go 4.6 miles and turn right onto Plymouth St.
ALTERNATE is to avoid the center of Boston and the tunnels take 93 to 495 S and follow directions for from the West.

From Maine:
Take 95 S to I-93 S to Route 3 via Exit 7 toward Cape Code, Braintree. Keep LEFT to merge onto MA-3 S. Take MA-3 to route 3A via Exit 9 toward Kingston, N Plymouth. Turn right onto Main St. go .5 miles and turn left to stay on Main St. continue onto Wapping Rd. go 4.6 miles and turn right onto Plymouth St.

From West:
Take I-495 S, to Route US- 44 via Exit 6 toward Middleboro, Plymouth. On US-44 go .3 miles turn right onto Harding St. then proceed to the roundabout, take the third exit onto US-44E. Follow US-44 to exit for MA-58 toward Carver, Plympton. Proceed for .3 miles and turn left onto N. Main St.. On N. Main St. go 2.3 miles then turn right on Main St. Follow Main St. for 2.3 miles and turn left onto County Rd. then proceeding .9 miles and turn right onto Plymouth St.

Summer Festival Horse Show Information – Rules and Regulations

- **All riders who wish to accumulate points for NHHJA year end awards and NH Medal points must be NHHJA members. Horse owners who wish to have their horses accumulate year end must be members.** Membership may be done online at www.nhhja.net. Membership forms will also be available at horse show office.

ENTRIES/OFFICE

- ❖ All entries accepted after Wednesday, July 1st will be charged a post entry fee of \$40/entry.
- ❖ Scratches prior to the close of entries will receive a full refund. **Scratches after the closing of pre-entries will be refunded entry fees, however, a \$50 scratch fee will apply, and stall fees will not be refunded.**
- ❖ All entries are required to pay \$2 NEHC fee, \$5 USHJA Outreach fee, and \$1 MHC fee.
- ❖ Returned checks will be charged a fee of \$100. Payment of return fee and initial amount shall be made within 2 weeks of notification.
- ❖ Payment by credit card will be accepted. There will be a 3% fee charged for this service.
- ❖ ALL JUMPER CLASSICS, HUNTER CLASSICS & HUNTER DERBIES require that the horse MUST compete in at least one other class at this show to be eligible.
- ❖ Horse show office will open 1 hour prior to start time, and close 1/2 hour after the end of show day. Any splits must be made by the end of the show day on Friday.
- ❖ Horses on the grounds but not showing, will be charged a grounds fee of \$75.
- ❖ A \$40 grounds fee will be charged to all entries. This will include unjudged warm ups on Tuesday only.
- ❖ Unjudged/Ticketed warm ups available as posted in schedule; \$25 per round. Hacking available as posted on schedule. NHHJA reserves the right to cancel/change warm ups and/or hacking as necessary.
- ❖ All prize money will be applied to show bill. Excess winnings will be mailed within 30 days.

STABLING

- ❖ Horses are not permitted on the show grounds before 3:00PM on Monday, July 13th.
- ❖ Horses must be off the show grounds 1 hour after the show concludes on Sunday, July 5th.
- ❖ Stalls are \$295 each for the week if payment is made in full, and mailed with stall form, prior to closing date for entries (July 1st). Stalls not paid for by closing date will be \$340 each. Open checks will not be accepted for stall fees. **No refund of stall fees after the closing date of entries...NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ❖ A mandatory weekly night watch fee of \$20.00 per stall occupied by a horse will be added to your show bill. This fee cannot be disputed.
- ❖ Hay and shavings can be pre-ordered on stall form.
- ❖ Medical Waste/Sharps: All sharps and needles must be disposed of properly in the sharps containers located in each barn. Failure to do so will result in a \$50 fine per occurrence.
- ❖ The use of two wire extension cords and stall fans is prohibited on showgrounds. All extension cords and fans must be grounded (three wire/prong) plugs. No exceptions.
- ❖ **Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any property damages caused by them, or their horse(s). Repair expenses will be billed accordingly, if not during the event, then immediately afterward. Failure to pay will result in suspension of membership until debt is paid in full.**

CAMPERS

- ❖ A limited number of RV spaces are available for weekly fee of \$375. Electric and water are included. No septic, so all RVs must be self-contained. Reservations are first come, first served basis. **Reservations must be made at www.nhhja.net....NO EXCEPTIONS.** Camper spots are NON-REFUNDABLE after the closing date of the horse show. Each reservation will be assigned a camper pass which will be emailed to recipient. This pass must be displayed in your camper at all times.
- ❖ The discharge of gray water and raw sewage is strictly prohibited on showgrounds.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- ❖ **Horse Health Requirements ***Must be submitted via email to show secretary prior to arrival***** include negative coggins within 12 months; EIV (Equine Influenza) and EHV-1/EHV-4 (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccines within 6 months. In addition, horses must have shown no signs of infectious disease and may not had a fever above 102 degrees F within 72 hours of arrival.
- ❖ Helmets must meet or exceed ASTM/SEI standards and be worn at all times while mounted. Chin straps must be securely fastened.
- ❖ Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or action resulting from their dog's behaviors.
- ❖ Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

GENERAL RULES

- ❖ NHHJA management reserves the right to limit entries, cancel, combine, or split any class, section or division; to add a dotted line; to reschedule classes, change rings, or change specifications in jumper classes due to time constraints.
- ❖ **Please note that there will be no holds on flat classes for trainer conflicts.**
- ❖ NHHJA horse shows abide by the rules and regulations of the New England Horsemen's Council and USEF.
- ❖ All entries for NEHC medal classes must have their membership number or a copy of their temporary membership card with them. Entries without membership numbers will not be accepted. If you know you are a member and cannot remember your number, you can fill out a Membership Affidavit. There is a \$25.00 fee which will be returned to you when your membership is validated. If you join NEHC at the horse show, please make sure you get your Temporary Membership from the show office.
- ❖ Lungeing and schooling will only be permitted in designated areas. Please do not lunge or school on the grass!
- ❖ NHHJA is an USHJA affiliate Organization and part of the USHJA Outreach Program please see their website at <https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach> for more information on the program.

SUMMER FESTIVAL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

The United States Equestrian Federation (USEF, www.usef.org) requires ALL persons mounted on a horse to wear properly fitted ASTM approved helmet with harness secured.

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION DIVISIONS

No rider may enter classes for more than one age group. The exhibitor's age for competition will follow NEHC rules, age as of December 1. Points can be accumulated only in the age group indicated on the application for membership. Martingales are prohibited on the flat.

Prize and 8 ribbons in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion in each division.

***SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION** - Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown higher than 18" at any recognized show.

1. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION FLAT - To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at a time.

2, 3*. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION OVER FENCES – To be shown over a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height. Course may be taken at the trot or canter. Simple changes of lead shall not be penalized.

(*class #3 MHJ Short Stirrup Medal qualifying class)

Entry Fee: \$105 for division or \$40 per class

***LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION** - Open to riders 13 years of age and older. Riders cannot have shown higher than 2' at any recognized show.

4. LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION FLAT - To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at a time.

5, 6*. LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION OVER FENCES – To be shown over a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height. Course may be taken at the trot or canter. Simple changes of lead shall not be penalized.

(*class #6 MHJ Long Stirrup Medal qualifying class)

Entry Fee: \$105 for division or \$40 per class

***PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION** - fence heights not to exceed 2'. Open to junior riders. Riders cannot have shown in classes higher than 2'6" at any recognized show in the current show season.

7. PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION FLAT

8, 9. PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION OVER FENCES

Entry Fee: \$105 for division or \$40 per class

***PRE-ADULT EQUITATION** - fence heights not to exceed 2'. Open to amateur adult riders who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at any recognized show in the current show season.

229. PRE-ADULT EQUITATION FLAT

230, 231. PRE-ADULT EQUITATION OVER FENCES

Entry Fee: \$105 for division or \$40 per class

***MODIFIED CHILDREN'S EQUITATION** – fences not to exceed 2'3". Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2'6" at any recognized show.

11. MODIFIED CHILDREN'S EQUITATION FLAT

12, 13. MODIFIED CHILDREN'S EQUITATION OVER FENCES

Entry Fee: \$105 for division or \$40 per class

***MODIFIED (LOW) AMATEUR ADULT EQUITATION** – fences 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'9" at a recognized show in the current show season. Riders in this division cannot show in any other classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6".

15. MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION FLAT

16, 17, 18. MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION OVER FENCES

- NEHC/MHC AA Rated

Entry Fee: \$105 for division or \$40 per class

***CHILDREN'S EQUITATION** - fence heights not to exceed 2'6" for horses and large ponies, 2' for small and medium ponies. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2'9" at any recognized show.

19. CHILDREN'S EQUITATION FLAT

20, 21, 22. CHILDREN'S EQUITATION OVER FENCES

- NEHC/MHC AA Rated

Entry Fee: \$140 for division or \$40 per class

***HUNT SEAT EQUITATION UNDER 12** – fence heights not to exceed 2'

23. HUNT SEAT EQUITATION UNDER 12 FLAT

24, 25, 26. HUNT SEAT EQUITATION UNDER 12 OVER FENCES

39. AMATEUR ADULT EQUITATION 18-35 FLAT

40, 41, 42. AMATEUR ADULT EQUITATION 18-35 OVER FENCES

Entry Fee: \$140 for division or \$40 per class

MEDAL CLASSES

Entry Fee: \$45 per medal class unless otherwise noted.

46, 47. NH ADULT MEDAL – fences not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-23. NH Adult Medal and NH Junior Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.

Note: When rider wins Adult medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals, but may return to compete in the class the following year.

48, 49. NH JUNIOR MEDAL – fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-23. NH Junior Medal and NH Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.

Note: When rider wins Junior medal class at year-end finals, the rider no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

50, 51. NH Mini Medal - fence heights not to exceed 2'6" for large ponies/horses, 2' for small/medium ponies. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 3' at any recognized show. Children's riders must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum

of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. NH Children's Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Modified Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.

Note: If a rider wins Children's medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals.

52, 53. NH MODIFIED CHILDREN'S MEDAL – fence heights not to exceed 2'3". Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. NH Modified Children's Medal, NH Adult Mini Medal and/or NH Mini Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.

Note: When rider wins Modified Children's medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals.

54, 55. NH Adult Mini Medal – fences 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'9" at a recognized show in the current show season. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. NH Adult Mini Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Mini Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height. *Note: When rider wins Adult Mini medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals but may return to compete in the class the following year.*

56, 57. NH NOVICE MEDAL – fence heights not to exceed 18". Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have never shown higher than 2' at a recognized show. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. Simple changes shall not be penalized. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge.

Note: When rider wins Novice medal class at year-end finals 2 years consecutively, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

326, 327. NH PRE CHILD/ADULT MEDAL - fence heights not to exceed 2'. Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have not shown higher than 2'3" at a recognized show in the current show season. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge.

Note: When rider wins Pre Child/Adult medal class at year-end finals 2 years consecutively, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

65, 66. NEHC ADULT MEDAL - Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a height from 2'9" to 3' with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-23). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. If there are not 3 riders in either or both the Junior or Adult Hunt Seat Medal qualifying class, they can be combined to meet the 3 rider minimum. Riders would show at their respective heights.

67, 68. NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL - Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set to a height from 3' to 3'3" with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-23). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. If there are not 3 riders in either or both the Junior or Adult Hunt Seat Medal qualifying class, they can be combined to meet the 3 rider minimum. Riders would show at their respective heights.

69, 70. MHC JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL- May compete after qualifying. Open to Junior members of MHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. Ten points are required to qualify for finals. To fill the class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both Junior or Adult Medal qualifying class, the show can

combine to meet the rider requirement. Riders will show at their respective heights. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF tests 1-23).

71, 72. MHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL - May compete after qualifying. Open to adult members of MHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6"-2'9", with at least one change of direction. To fill a class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both Junior or Adult Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement. Riders will show at their respective heights. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF tests 1-23).

73, 74. MHC HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL – Open to members of MHC who have not reached their 15th birthday and have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to perform over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, excluding combination fences at a height not to exceed 2'6" for horses and ponies. May compete after qualifying. Ten points are required to qualify for finals. A Mini Medal rider who competes in the Junior Medal prior to the finals is no longer eligible for the Mini Medal Final. One or more test may be requested at the judge's discretion. To fill the class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both the Mini Medal or Adult Mini Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement.

234, 235. MHC ADULT HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL - Open to adult members of MHC who have not jumped 2'9" or higher in the past 2 years. All contestants are to perform over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, excluding combination fences at a height not to exceed 2'6" for horses and ponies. To fill a class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course. Riders **may** compete after qualifying. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both the Mini Medal or Adult Mini Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement.

3. MHJ SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL (class #3 qualifying class) – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. To perform over at least four fences not to exceed 18". Riders **may not** compete in any other equitation class other than Short Stirrup Equitation, at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18". Any Short Stirrup Equitation class(es) or Championship class may be used as the qualifying Class as long as the show program specifies. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.
Entry Fee: \$40.00

6. MHJ Long Stirrup Medal (class #6 qualifying class) – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. To perform over at least four fences not to exceed 18". Riders **may not** compete in any other equitation class other than Short Stirrup Equitation, at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18". Any Short Stirrup Equitation class(es) or Championship class may be used as the qualifying Class as long as the show program specifies. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

75. MHJ MINI MEDAL – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year [exception Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year.] To perform over at least six fences **not to exceed** 2'6". At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class. Riders may cross-enter into the Children's Equitation Medal but can only compete in either the Mini-Medal **or** Children's Equitation Medal **but not both at the finals**.

76. MHJ ADULT MINI MEDAL - Open to all Adult Amateur riders that have not shown over a course where the fences exceeded 3' in the current year. To perform over a course of at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count. Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal.

77. MHJ ADULT MEDAL – Open to all Adult Amateur competitors to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least two changes of direction and a combination. At the finals, class will be divided 18-30 and 31 and over. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

78. MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. To perform over at least six fences not to exceed 3'. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 Points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

79. MHJ CHILDREN'S EQUITATION MEDAL– Open to all horses and ponies. Open to riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Riders may not cross enter into junior equitation. Fences 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies/horses. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count.

JUMPER DIVISIONS

- Class payouts for all jumper classes (excluding USHJA Outreach classes) and are as follows: \$40, \$30, \$20, \$10. Money from 1st to 4th place, ribbons to 8th place.
- Champion and Reserve Champion awarded in each division.

84, 85, 86. NOVICE JUMPER – Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Fences not to exceed 2'. No combinations. Entry Fee: \$135 for division or \$50 per class

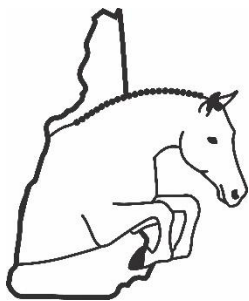
